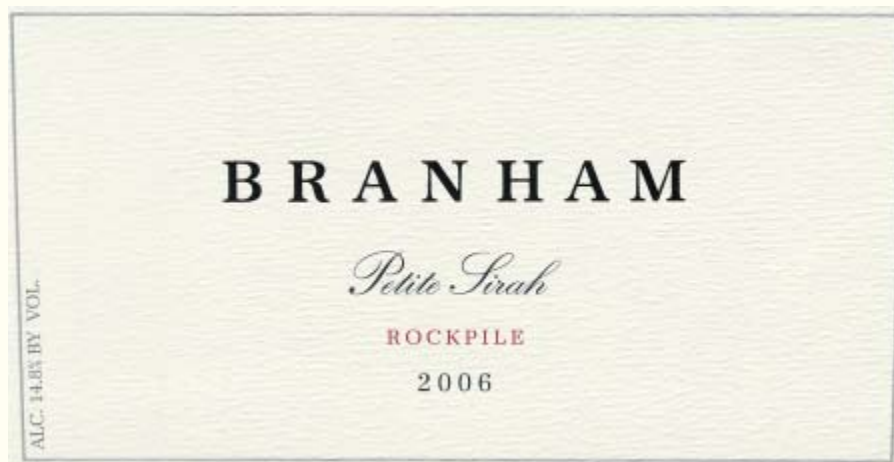


BRANHAM Estate Wines

This varietal is ideally suited for the rough and tumble terroir of the Rockpile--high elevation, rocky soil, and fog-free temperatures.
