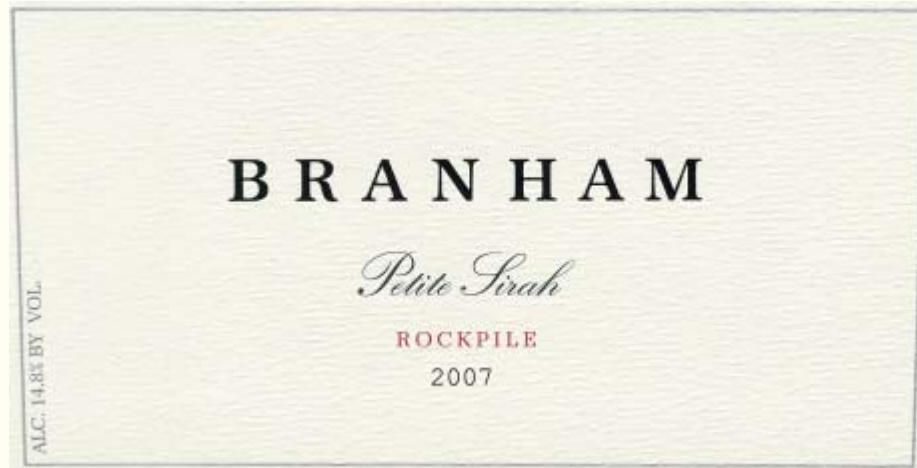


BRANHAM Estate Wines
