One group of particular notariety consists of serious wine folk who decided to plant small vineyards dedicated to their favorite varietal ~ Pinot Noir. This wine is predominately from the Gioia Vineyard near Occidental in the renowned SC Pinot Noir appellation. In the nose is the earthy, forest floor of our beloved Redwoods, replete with aeromatic mushrooms and loam. On the palate a surprise of cherries and raspberries, and true to its heritage as the ultimate food wine a long, silky finish.
