


BRANHAM

The first zinfandel planted in 1994 at the Branham Rockpile vineyard forms the backbone for this outstanding representative of the famous "Rockpile" terroir. We now utilize our other vineyards, planted later, as well as the original, selecting blocks of each to create this signature wine in our Sonoma County portfolio. Dark ruby color and deeply brilliant purple tones imbue this wine. Ample dark berry aromas, enhanced by light smoky notes and balanced tannins and acid pervade the palate with each taste. The familiar blackberry flavor of this "Branham Rockpile" Zin resonates at the finish.
